
Dear Governor Minner,

We are in receipt of Senate Bill No. 18 & 19 that together create the Sustainable Energy Utility (SEU) and propose an increase to Delaware's Renewable Portfolio Standard. This legislation could bring Delaware to a leading position as a national model for how states can act to reduce energy use and contribute to the control of our national carbon footprint.

The SEU will help provide Delawareans with access to a wide variety of renewable energy options, including solar for their homes and businesses. Enacting the Sustainable Energy Utility will facilitate consumer choice, save all Delawareans money, and help move Delaware to the forefront of energy policy nationwide.

Additionally with the forward thinking two megawatt net metering rule, a stronger Green Energy Fund, a Renewable Portfolio Standard that decrees the goal of reducing Delaware's energy use by 30% before the year 2015 including a 100 MW solar carve out to be achieved by 2019 is proactive and ambitious. The future Delawareans will thank this administration for acting on their behalf and the present Delawareans will enjoy the necessary incentives to facilitate the growth of Delaware's PV market and the overall environmental health of the Delmarva Peninsula.
